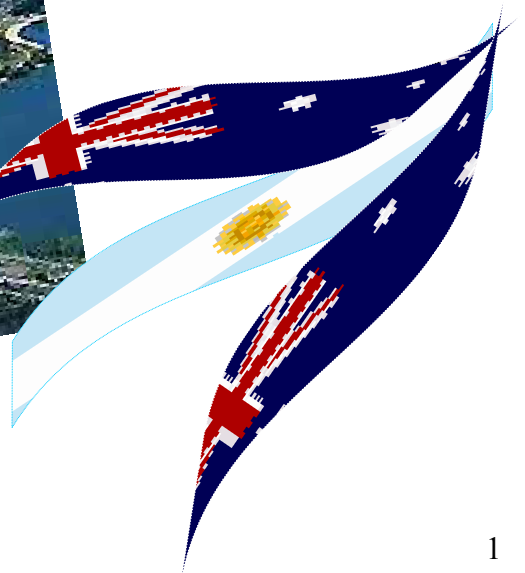

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# **EATING DISORDERS IN ADOLESCENTS**

Day after day it is more common to listen how difficult adolescents are. Adolescence is a process of critical transformations in diverse phases which are mainly shown in the biological, the psychological and the social aspects.

Some specialists state that the critical transformations of adolescent are subject to imbalances and extreme uncertainties, which are denominated by A. Aberastury<sup>1</sup> as "Normal syndrome of the adolescence". These uncertainties can be characterized by the resolution of different bereavements, such as the bereavement for the infantile body, the identity and for the ideal position parents had for adolescents while they were still children. Such bereavements propitiate a process of lose, pain and recovery.

Adolescence derives from suffering, and according to the Encarta dictionary it can be explained as: 'The period from puberty to adulthood in human beings. The adolescence is a period of human beings between the infancy and the adult age (between the 12 and the 20 years)'. This period is characterized for a multitude of transformations that change according to the socioeconomic conditions, and many, according to technologically different societies' developments that can sometimes happen inadvertent. The term adolescent has varied according to the times and the societies.

This article is not going to be focused on adolescence in itself but on the problems that appear during this period such as

## **Eating disorders in the adolescents**

Eating disorders are illnesses produced by anxiety, stress, low self-esteem and excessive worry for physical aspect and body weight. Most of the eating problems that many people have when they are adults start when they are still teenagers.

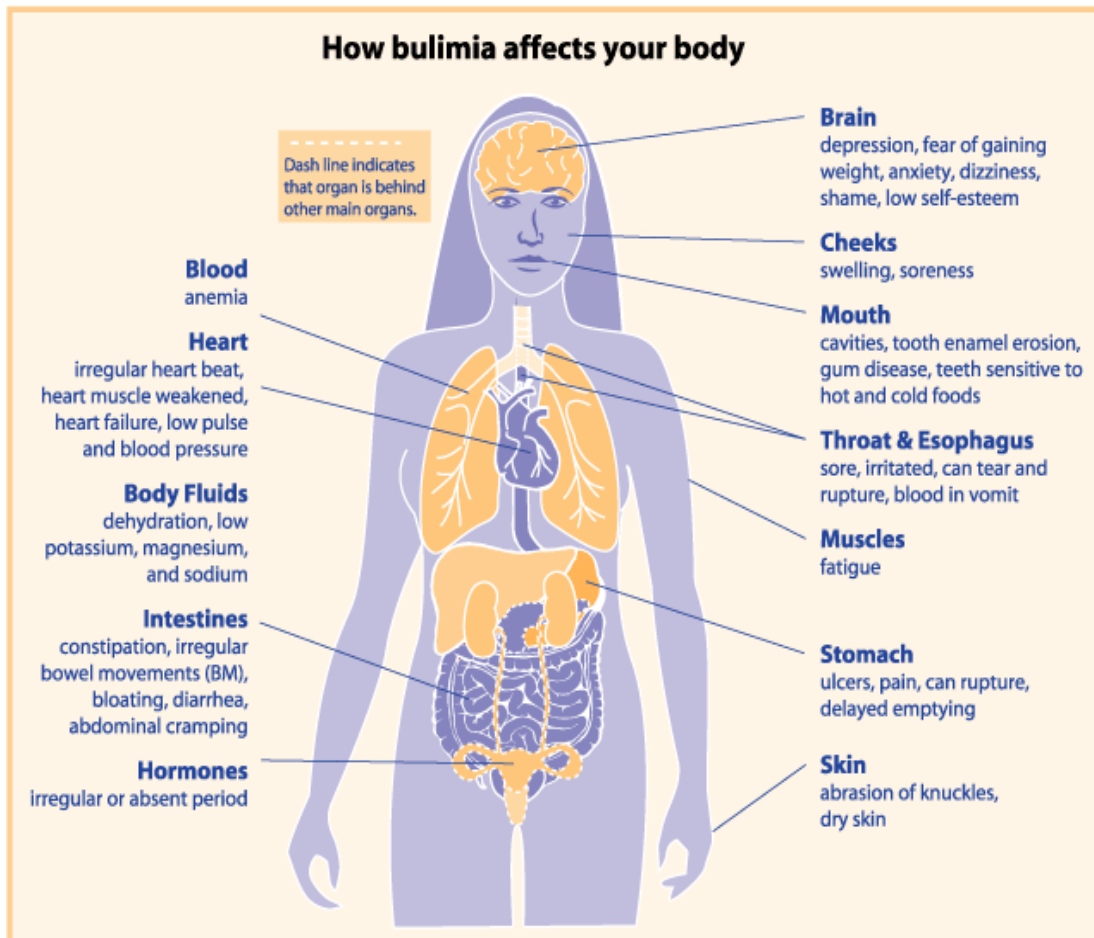
The most common eating disorders are anorexia, nervous breakdowns, which make girls or boys be sick, and bulimia. Anorexia is an illness in itself. Its can be described as 'loss of appetite especially when prolonged'. Sometimes it is produced because many people feel scared to become fat and decide to stop eating in order to look themselves thin. Furthermore there is another sort of anorexia known as anorexia nervosa. It has been defined as 'a serious disorder in eating behavior primarily of young women in their teens and early twenties that is especially characterized



by a pathological fear of gaining weight which leads to faulty eating patterns, malnutrition, and usually excessive weight loss'. A good example of this problem has been depicted by an Australian student's brother who suffered from this problem. In the school teachers and professionals tried to help him, the same as his partners and family. Thanks to them, he could overcome his problem.



Another illness is a bulimia. It is an illness in which the person eats in excess or has regular episodes of excessive ingestion of food and feels a control loss. The affected person uses diverse methods then, such as to vomit or to consume laxatives in excess, to prevent the increase of weight. Bulimia is an illness that appears more in women than in men.



## Relationship between bulimia and anorexia

In the last years the number of anorexic patient with bulimic symptoms has increased. One of the factors is the social pressure growth which gives the wrong idea that to be successful, it is necessary to be thin. Lately, the number of people asking for assistance on anorexia has remained stable, but the number of bulimic patients has increased notably. The cycles of gorging and vomiting seem to be due to the same factors that those which lead to anorexia, for that reason they are inevitably related.



The lack of food is not the only eating disorder; obesity can also be considered anorexia and bulimia's counterparts. Obesity is a chronic illness originated by many causes and with numerous complications. It is characterized by the excess of fat in the organism and it is presented when the Index of Corporal Mass<sup>2</sup> is bigger than 25 units in adults. Obesity is the result of incorporating more calories than those which the body needs. For example In Australia, approximately 16% of teenagers are obese.

## **Types of obesity**

According to the distribution of the corporal fat the following types exist:

**Obesity android:** It is located in the face, neck, trunk and part superior of the abdomen. It is the most frequent in men.

**Obesity ginecoide:** It prevails in inferior abdomen, hips, buttocks and gluteus. It is more frequent in women.

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# Problems between teenagers and parents

During the teenage stage, parents and children have many problems because the world opens in a different way for teenagers. The young people start exploring new boundaries such as, freedom and autonomy which sometimes lead to drugs. One of the principal problems between them is that some parents do not talk about sex and drugs with the children or if they do, they do it in a wrong way.

But, often, the parents have problems with their young people because they do not understand that their offspring are growing. Many parents try to defend themselves by stating arguments such as "My son is always on the phone, sleeping, out with his friends, or in his room. He never has time to talk to me" or "every time I try to explain something to my daughter or give her advice, she gets upset and storms out of the room"; "when I talk to my child, he gives me a blank stare and he or she is obviously not listening to anything I am saying". Other arguments which are often listened are: "My son never tells me when something is bothering her. I never know how she is feeling. She keeps everything to herself" and/or "If I ask my son a simple question like "How was your day?" he gets irritated and gives me a sharp answer. I can't even talk to him about simple things like his daily activities".

## And what about the adolescents' point of view ?

On the other hand, children state that their parents are always over controlling them by asking questions such as: "Where did you go?"; "Who did you go with?"; "Did you have fun?". "When my friends come over, my parents even ask them a bunch of stupid questions, too, like "Where do you go to school?" or "Where does your dad work?"."

Other teenagers feel that their parents are completely unable of understanding them and that everything they do seems to be wrong. This can be clearly seen by some adolescents' opinion when they were asked about their parents. Here there are a number of young adults' opinions about their parents:

- "My parents don't understand me. They are living in another time period."
- "The only time my father talks to me is when I do something wrong or when he's trying to point out what I should do".
- "It seems as though every time I tell my parents what my opinion is or how I feel, they tell me how wrong I am or why I shouldn't feel that way".
- "Every time I ask my parents something, I get a lecture. My mother is always talking and I can't get a word in. She asks me a question and then gives me the answer".

Having stated this problem, we interviewed Rodrigo Josserme (mat. 46692) and we asked these two questions which are quite relevant

**Are parents the main responsible for teenagers' start with certain addictions, such as drugs?**

I think it depends on a lot of factors. One of those is the communication between the parents and children. The lack of communication causes that many children start consuming drugs but, parents are not the only responsible. Many of young people live in environments where drug consumption is something usual and the drug peddlers sell their drug to many teenagers, who are in a very vulnerable moment of their lives.

**Which are the most usual problems between parents and their teenage children?**

The lack of communication leads to drug abuse and early sexual starting which directs to unwanted pregnancies and venereal illnesses. And when adults try to set limits, these actions triggers serious quarrels.

A good piece of advice: Let's allow parents to children and vice versa the time to talk, and to think about their feelings and stages in life.-

# Problems of drugs, tobacco and alcohol in Australian teenagers

In Australia, there are many cases of drug and alcohol in teenagers. From Mar del Plata, Argentina, one of the goals of this article is to arise conscience in adolescents and readers in general who could be interested in these problems that affect not only Australia and Argentina but is present in all around the world.

## Tobacco

In Australia, there are restrictions on the sale and publicity of tobacco, and smoking in the public places. "The restrictions vary in the different states and territories of Australia <sup>3</sup>". In Australia more than 40% of teenagers smoke

tobacco. The age in teenager of start smoking tobacco is 16. The smoking of tobacco among children raise with the age. By the age of 17, 17 % of women smoke and 19% of men smoke. The proportion of smoking men and women is similar through all ages. The restrictions vary

according to Australian different Territories Laws. "We live in Canberra. Here, in the Australian Capital Territory the laws restricting smoking are very harsh<sup>4</sup>". Since December 2006 there has been a total ban on smoking in all public areas in the capital.

Furthermore Gabbie, Issi and Tess said: "In Australia the people have laws against smoking for people who are younger than 18, but they have many problems with underage smoking, etc<sup>5</sup>".

Some parents of teenagers sometimes know that their children consume tobacco. Without realizing, parents are sometimes responsible of this, because they smoke in front of them, so they take up the habit of their parents.

## **Drugs**

Illegal drugs attract political interest in Australia. People are interested in illicit drugs because it is a huge problem there. Some adolescents indulge themselves in drug consumption, even though most of them know that they are deadly dangerous. The more consumed drugs are: marijuana, cocaine and tobacco.

The restrictions vary in the different places of Australia. There are the states in which drugs are completely prohibited: South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, Northern Territory and Australian Capital Territory. Many people think that the teenagers start consuming drugs because they are depressed or have problems at home or school.

## **Alcohol**

Many teenagers drink alcohol because they want to spend more time with friends, and they usually go to places where alcohol is freely sold. In Australia, the legal drinking age is 18 years old but as it happens in Argentina, some teenagers drink alcohol before the legal age. The drinking age is different according to the place. For example, in Victoria it is 16 years old and in Canberra it is 18 years old.

In Australia, there are non governmental organizations which find their Argentinean counterparts in "Alcoholicos Anónimos", for example: "The Alcohol and other Drugs Council of Australia (ADCA)". These organizations work in order to reduce alcohol and drug consumption all around the country. This chart clearly explains how they operate:



The Alcohol and other Drugs Council of Australia (ADCA) is the Australian most important and non-governmental organization which represents the interests of the Australian alcohol and other drugs preventive-action sector, and provides a national voice for people working to reduce the harm caused by alcohol and other drugs. ADCA works collaboratively with the government, non-government, business and community sectors to promote evidence-based, socially just, approaches aimed at preventing or reducing the health, economic and social harm caused by alcohol and other drugs to individuals, families, communities and the nation.

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# “Warning: adolescents are in problems”

Are adolescents understood?? This is a key question since many people blame them even without understanding the changes adolescents suffer. These changes happen not only at the physical level but also at the psychological one. They are very relevant at this stage of growth<sup>1 6</sup>.

It is well known that adolescence<sup>2</sup> is a stormy and emotionally aggressive stage. It produces a rapid physical development as well as deep emotional changes. This generally is given since the persons grow and mature very rapidly. Due to these changes, many problems arise between parents and children, and sometimes, parents do not agree with their children or do not understand them.

Sometimes these matters are reflected in physical and psychological problems such as anorexia<sup>3</sup>, bulimia<sup>4</sup>, obesity<sup>5</sup>, and learning issues like tiredness due to excessive timetables and school schedules.

Inquired about this topic, some Australian students explain: “Teenagers are faced with many of the issues common in other countries. Estimates suggest that around half of the population over the age of 14 years drinks alcohol at least weekly. Unsafe sex practices and unwanted pregnancy are significant health issues for teenagers. 4.8% of adolescents suffer from clinical depression. Many teens are also resorting to such drugs as ecstasy and cannabis”<sup>7</sup>

About physical problems, eating disorders is the most serious. These disorders can lead to important problems such as obesity. This disorder is closely related to high blood pressure, asthma and certain kinds of cancer and diabetes. Many studies state that obesity can reduce a person's life span up to ten years. The heavier the person is, the greater the risk of death the person has.

Another serious and usually hidden problem that affects many adolescents is school overloaded schedules. This problem seems to be quite invisible to many adults but it can result in serious psychological problems. These problems can be lack of rest, irritability, poor performance. It is important that teenagers realize about this difficulty and look for help within their families or with some specialists

Are adolescents understood? According to this article and it seems that a large number of adolescence are not well understood either by their parents nor by the adult society without solutions or counseling for their problems many of them start following a wrong a dangerous path that leads into drug consumption.

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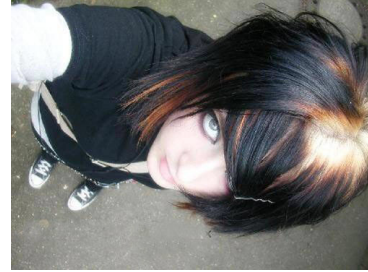
# Emos and Bogans

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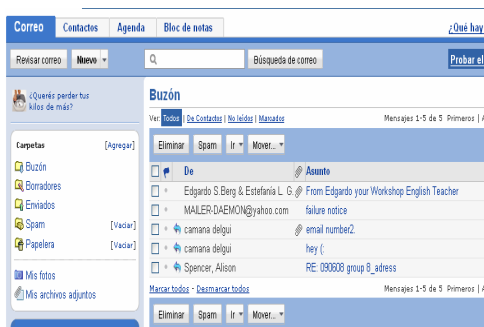
# My world, my rules

**W**hen listening to the radio, looking at the television, reading a book or simply talking to other persons, unconsciously or no, we are communicating. It is to say, we are establishing a relation with other people through oral (telephones; mobile telephone; etc.) or written (letters; ordinary mails; etc.) means. To talk about primitive methods our attention should go back up to the prehistory, when prehistoric people used sings, signals and pictures to send and receive messages. But nowadays, thanks to the technological advances which were discovered and are employed in communications, these have advanced tremendously and become very effective.

Though communications means have advanced a lot, this doesn't mean that every social class uses them. There is a sector of the society that goes on using traditional methods, for example books or ordinary mail. This is due to two causes: the first one is the socio-economic level, not everybody can afford to have and use the new technology as means of communication; and the second one, the age, because even though some grown ups use technology the majority prefers keeping in touch by using the traditional means. But thinking on adolescents, it can be said that nine out of ten have at least one mobile phone and eight out of ten have a computer with internet. This clearly shows that, adolescents use the technology more often than adults. The most popular modern means used by the adolescents are:

**Internet:** is a shared global computing network. A network, which enables global communications between all connected computing devices. It provides the platform for web services and the World Wide Web. Internet enables people to get communicated, to obtain information, to express in different manners, etc. For this to exist different means, those detections a continues:



**-Blogs:** is a web page that the author periodically loads with articles which containing

general or personal information. This information can be illustrated with photos and people can leave their comments so the author can send the answer



back, establishing the communication.

**-E-mail:** is a mails box where people can send and receive electronic messages, that is to say, it is like an ordinary mail but on the web. A huge change from this sort of mails is presented in shortening the time of sending and receiving and the lack of necessity of adding so much of the receivers' information. Too, photos can be attached.

**-Chat:** is a written communication between two or more persons



through internet, where photos and sounds can be sent by using a web cams and microphones. There are two types of chats: the first one is a web page where you only put a nick name and the second one is a program which must be downloaded. In this case, a nickname and a passwords are needed. The most popular program chat is



Windows Messenger (msn), where millions of children, adolescents and young adults among others can contact and be contacted among them.

- **Social reds:** Is a web page where people from different places and ages can contact with other people or can be contacted. The most popular one is Facebook, where people create and publish their profiles. On this social red, people can show images, photo, videos and other type publications. The social red is something similar to the chat.

- **Gallery photography:** these too are web pages, where the people upload photos with text. There people leave comments on those texts and photos. For example: Fotologs, Metroflogs, etc.



- **Magazine:** variety of them. plants, animals, buyers and fans their example TV



when talking about magazines, there is a wide variety of them. There are magazines focused on the cooking, etc. But among them adolescents are great of those that deal with topics which are related to programs, music and trends.

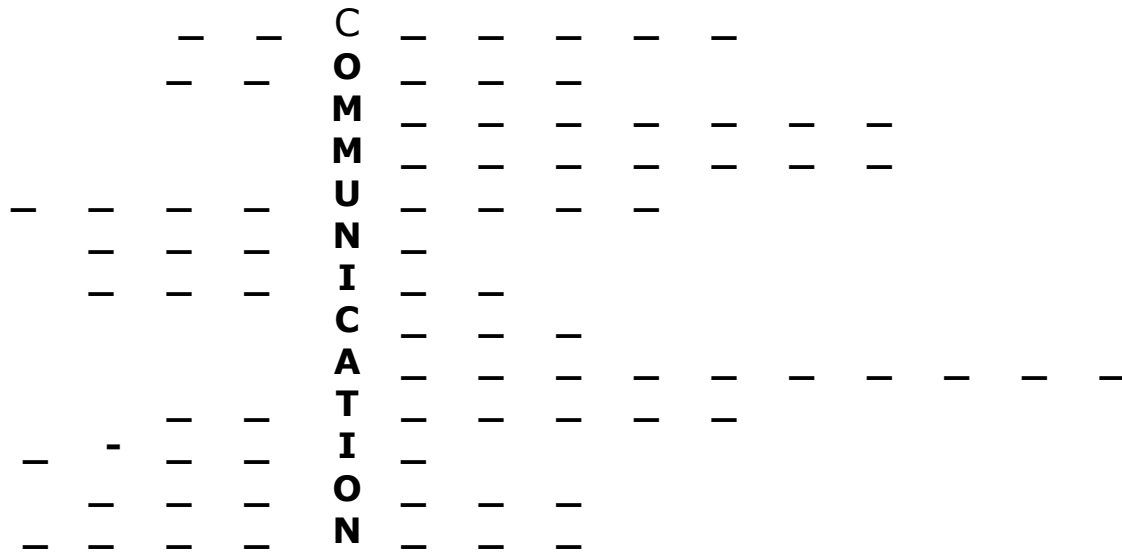
